Rosterfy is DEW's new Volunteer Management System (VMS), which is intended to streamline volunteer coordination and support.

Why do we need a VMS?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Currently volunteers in Friends of Parks and Nature (FoPN) groups are supported through a range of different, often manual, processes depending on the group, region or liaison ranger. This can create inconsistencies and make it harder to track activities, access information, and stay connected. To improve the volunteer experience, DEW has introduced a new Volunteer Management System called Rosterfy. This system provides one central platform for registration, rostering, communication, and training – making it easier for both staff and volunteers to stay informed, organised, and engaged. Please note: All volunteers will be required to register through Rosterfy. This ensures we can meet safety, insurance, and communication requirements across all groups and programs. It is a simple step that helps us support you better in your volunteer role.
How will Rosterfy benefit Friends of Parks and Nature groups?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grow and diversify your group with an easy online registration form for new volunteers. Less paperwork and forms!! Promote your activities to other groups and program members when extra hands are needed. A group leader can be nominated to record the attendance of volunteers at activities (or individuals may prefer to record their attendance). Track your group's impact with reporting functions. Support reward and recognition initiatives. Compliance with insurance requirements. Access to relevant policies, procedures and safety information. Track training, inductions, and screenings.
How will Rosterfy support Friends of Parks and Nature volunteers?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Easy sign ups – find and join activities without the email back-and-forth. Stay informed – access news, resources, training and safety information. Personal match – find other volunteer opportunities that suit your skills and interests. Track your hours – keep records for personal, recognition, or Centrelink use (and for the annual Parks Pass code!). Celebrate service – milestone tracking to recognise your hard work. Less admin, more impact – group leaders spend more time on conservation, less on logistics. Stay connected statewide – one system, many groups. See what other groups are doing around the state.
